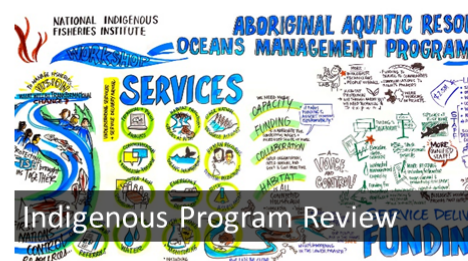

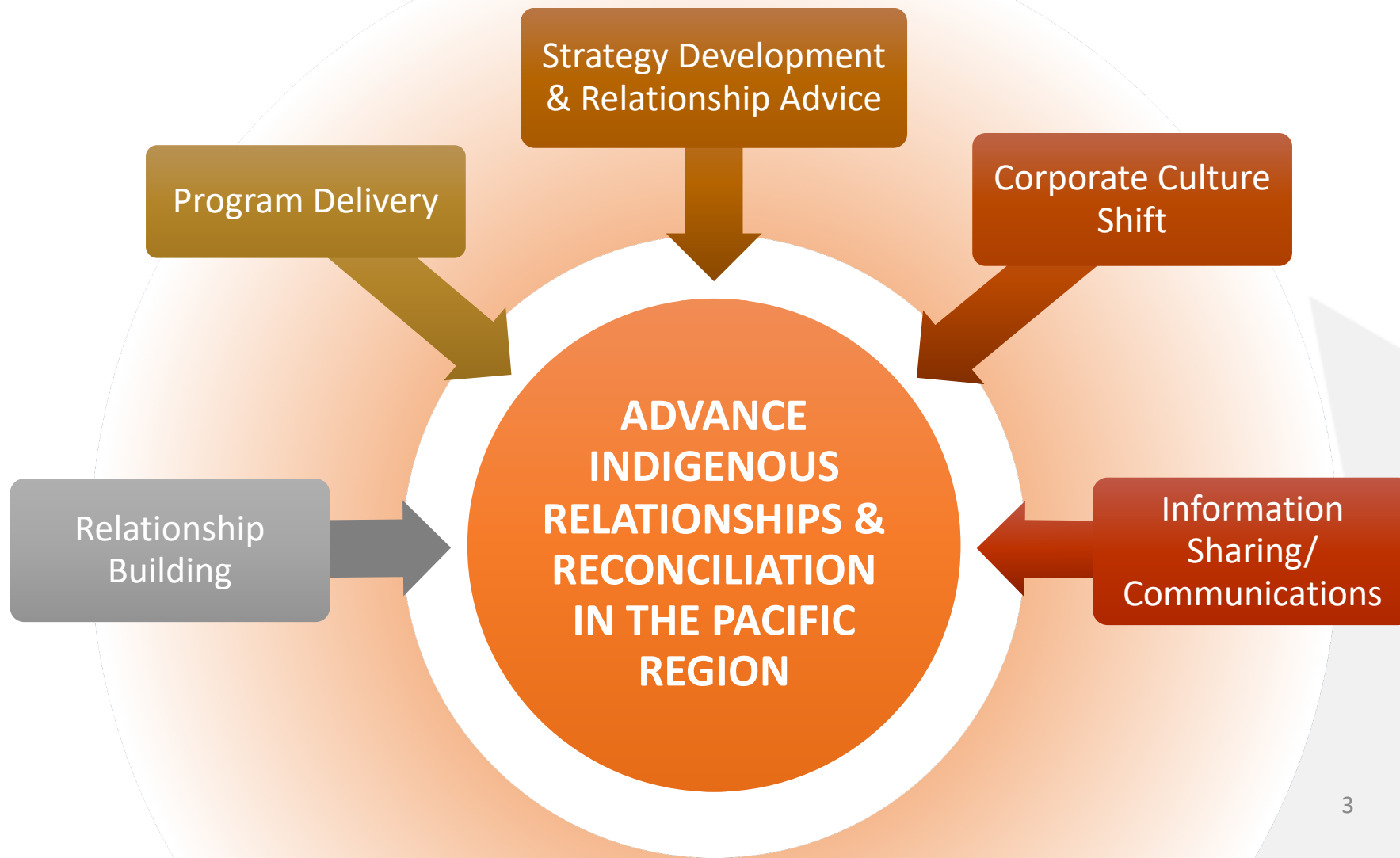

NATIONAL RECONCILIATION

DFO-CCG Reconciliation Strategy (September 6, 2019):

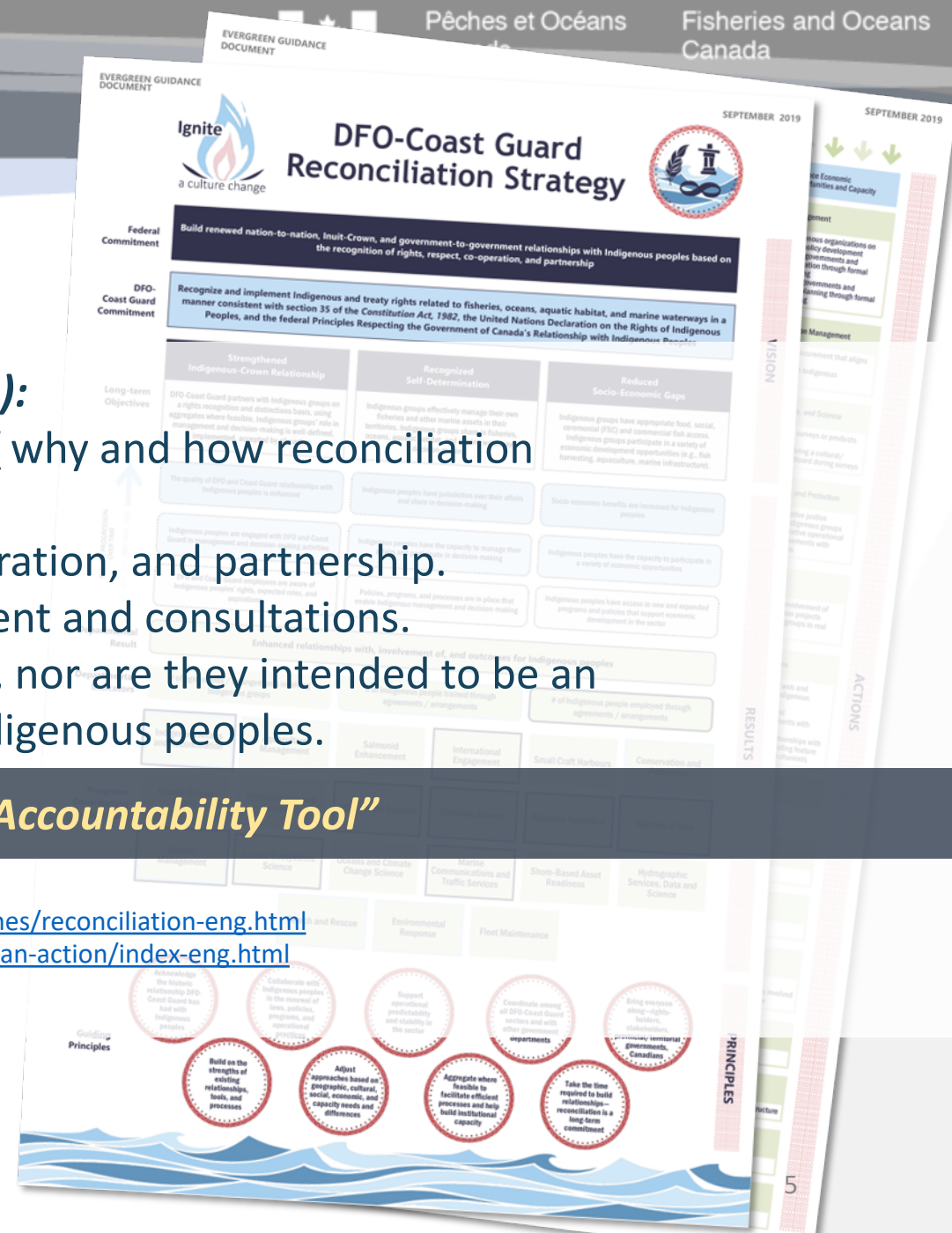
- Guidance document to help employees understand why and how reconciliation matters in their day-to-day work.
- Based on the recognition of rights, respect, co-operation, and partnership.
- Input obtained through past and current engagement and consultations.
- Evolving Process: Proposed objectives are not final, nor are they intended to be an attempt to define what reconciliation means to Indigenous peoples.

 - Salish Sea Initiative (SSI)
- **Development of Pacific Executive Performance Management Commitments on Indigenous Reconciliation**
- **Co-development of engagement and consultations approach on FSC**
- **Advancement of treaty and reconciliation tables (examples)**
 - Coastal First Nations Fisheries Resources Reconciliation Agreement
 - Heiltsuk Hałcístut Incremental House Post Agreement
 - Five Nuu-chah-nulth Nations Incremental Reconciliation Agreement for Fisheries Resources
 - Tsilhqot'in The Gwets'en Nilt'i Pathway Agreement
- **Working with Modern Treaty Nations in the Pacific Region**
 - 11 Yukon First Nations, Nisga'a Lisims Government, Tsawwassen First Nation, Tla'amin Nation, and Maa-nulth Nations

- **Fostering Co-Governance in Fisheries, Ocean Aquatic Management**
 - Fraser Salmon Collaborative Management Agreement
 - Central Coast Collaborative Crab Management
 - Hecate and SGaan Kinghlas-Bowie Seamount MPA: First Nations Co-governance planning
 - Reconciliation Framework Agreement for Bioregional Oceans Management and Protection
- **Fisheries Act Review** - Indigenous Knowledge (Grant Funding: Indigenous Habitat Participation Program); collaborative management and recognition of Indigenous Jurisdiction
- **Indigenous Program Review** – Co-designed, co-developed and co-delivered commercial and collaborative management programs
- **Oceans Protection Plan** – Implementation with Indigenous participation
